Pamela Timanson Appointed to CCCEP Board of Directors

September 19, 2017 Saskatoon, Saskatchewan – Effective today, Pamela Timanson, Competence Director for the Alberta College of Pharmacists (ACP) was appointed to the Board of Directors of the Canadian Council on Continuing Education in Pharmacy (CCCEP). Ms. Timanson replaces Debbie Lee who served as the ACP representative to the Board from 2012 to 2017.

In addition to her position with the Alberta College of Pharmacists, Ms. Timanson is also an Adjunct Professor with the Faculty of Education, Department of Educational Policy Studies at the University of Alberta. Her doctoral research focused on the examination of how teachers learn informally within the knowledge culture of their workplace.
